4. RESOLUTION - APPLICATION TO APPROVE BORROWING

BE IT RESOLVED that the Clerk and/or Treasurer and/or Mayor be authorized to issue and sell to the New Brunswick Municipal Finance Corporation a Municipality of **Riverview** debenture in the amount of \$4,500,000 on such terms and conditions as are recommended by the New Brunswick Municipal Finance Corporation, and be it resolved that the Municipality of **Riverview** agree to issue post-dated cheques payable to the New Brunswick Municipal Finance Corporation as and when they are requested in payment of principal and interest charges on the above debenture.

R. Higson confirmed with Councillor Thorne that the interest rate would not be determined until the bonds are issued into the market. He also pointed out that the resolution to borrow is really a formality as the Town was already pre-

approved to borrow the \$5.4 million but as outlined in the Council Report Form it will only be borrowing \$4.5 million for the following 2018 Capital projects:

Parks and Recreation – Arena \$1,700,000

Transportation – Roads and Streets \$2,800,000
