Activities in Public Works:

- Crews have been busy patching water main breaks with the asphalt recycler. The
 asphalt recycler was out or service for most of January and February but is now back in
 service.
- Crews are filling potholes with hot mix asphalt or cold patch as the conditions warrants.
- Street and sidewalk sweeping will start as soon as ice and snow is gone.
- Crews will begin to inspect and repair street signs as needed once snow is melted.
- Our evening and night shift continue to monitor icy situations (streets and sidewalks) and apply salt as needed.
