9. **BY-LAWS**

By-Law 300-7-1 а.

A By-Law to Amend the Town of Riverview Zoning By-Law

First Reading, by title only

The Town Clerk noted that the purpose of this by-law is to amend the Zoning By-law by rezoning PID 05103080 from R1 (Single Unit Dwelling) to R2 (Two Unit Dwelling).

The by-laws will be read for the first time by title only and if passed will be posted on the town's web site for review. As governed by the Local Governance Act each of these by-laws need a 2/3 vote of Council to pass – which equates to 4 of the 6 members present.
