Activities in Public Works:

- A crew is working on sweeping all concrete islands. The street sweeper is cleaning the street gutter. This work will be on-going until completed.
- Crews are inspecting, repairing, and replacing street signs as necessary. This work will be on-going for another few weeks.
- Watermain flushing completed on May 17. The program improves the water quality and was very well executed.
- The temporary water pipe installation for Weir and Berkley is now done.
- Repairs to lawns from the winter operations have begun and will be on-going until all the lawns have been repaired. Weather continues to challenge the progress of this work.

Other Activities:

- Bulk garbage collection was held the week of May 13-17. Two additional days were necessary and all should be done by May 22.
- A anti-bullying and policy for preventing workplace violence was held on April 17 with the help of the Director and the Director of HR.
- Meetings with PW and Engineering continue to occur weekly to discuss activities and plan the summer's work flow.
- The on-boarding of the new Manager of Public Work continues since his arrival on April 23.
- The Director attended the press conference on April 25 on the gas tax funding.
- The Director continues to attend the following meetings: Traffic Committee, the engineering team, Transaqua technical committee, and CUPE labour relations.
- On May 8, the Director and the Manager of PW attended a full day workshop on the future direction of solid waste management for the region.
