Priority	Activities
Employee Engagement & Collaboration	<ul> <li>The focus of this objective is to lead and support the leadership team in executing employment engagement activities to strengthen and improve employee engagement at the Town of Riverview, which will help facilitate increased collaboration within the organization.</li> <li>Actions:</li> <li>The Engineering Leadership team was supported with a team building exercise for the entire team focused on developing trusting relationships within the team. This was one of the actions identified in an earlier review on the department's work culture.</li> <li>Training opportunities to support increased collaboration and communication are planned for the Fire Department in the fall, to support the creation of a collaborative working environment.</li> <li>Q2 performance management discussions were scheduled for the senior leadership during the last two weeks of June.</li> </ul>
Operational Excellence	<ul> <li>The focus of this objective is to lead the organization in the execution of initiatives that if implemented will strengthen, improve and modernize the Town's Operations (proper planning and allocation of continuous improvement budget).</li> <li>Actions:         <ul> <li>The Public Works Team reviewed and evaluated a software solution that if implemented would help manage workflow; tasks; work orders; and historical data on vehicle repairs for the Mechanic Shop. The proposed investment is being supported by the continuous improvement budget.</li> <li>The Facilities Coordinator evaluated an energy management tool that could be used in the Town's buildings to improve the energy efficiency and management of the Town's power consumption. The Coordinator has recommended a trial in one facility to determine if there is long term benefits to the organization.
