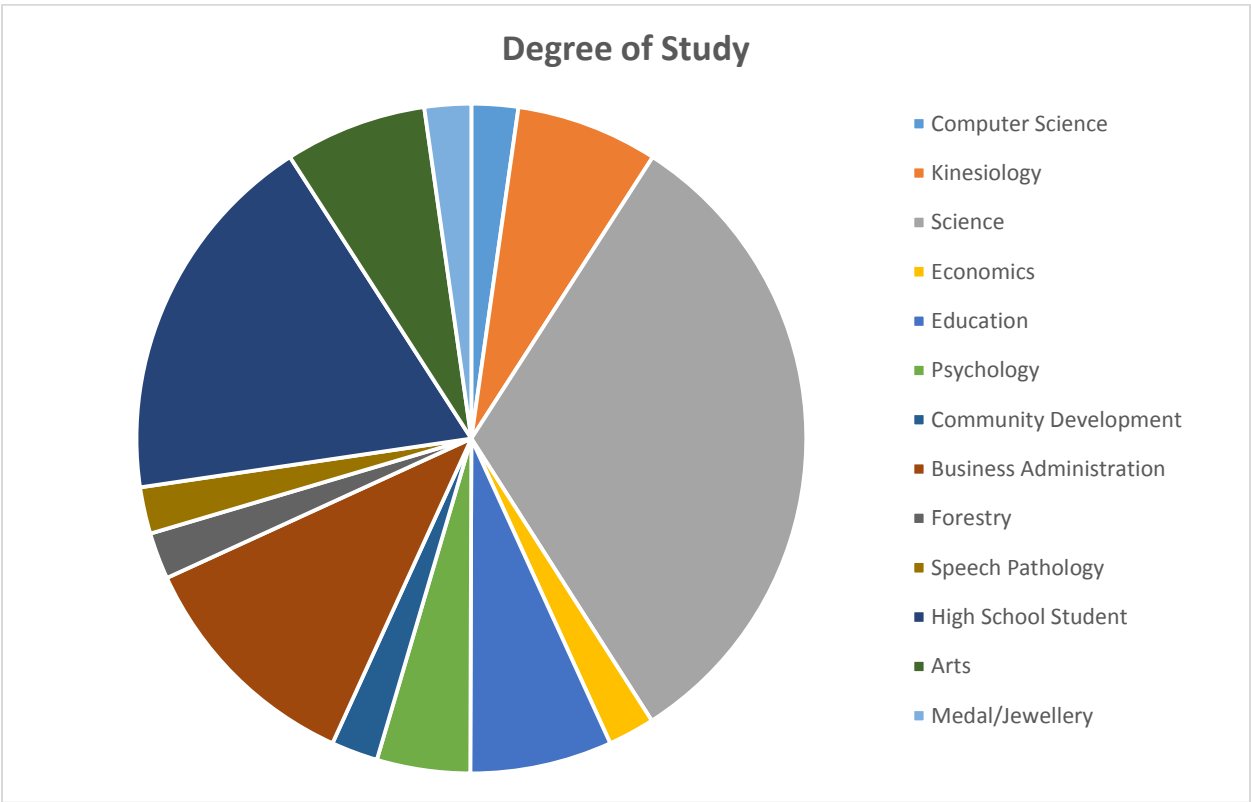
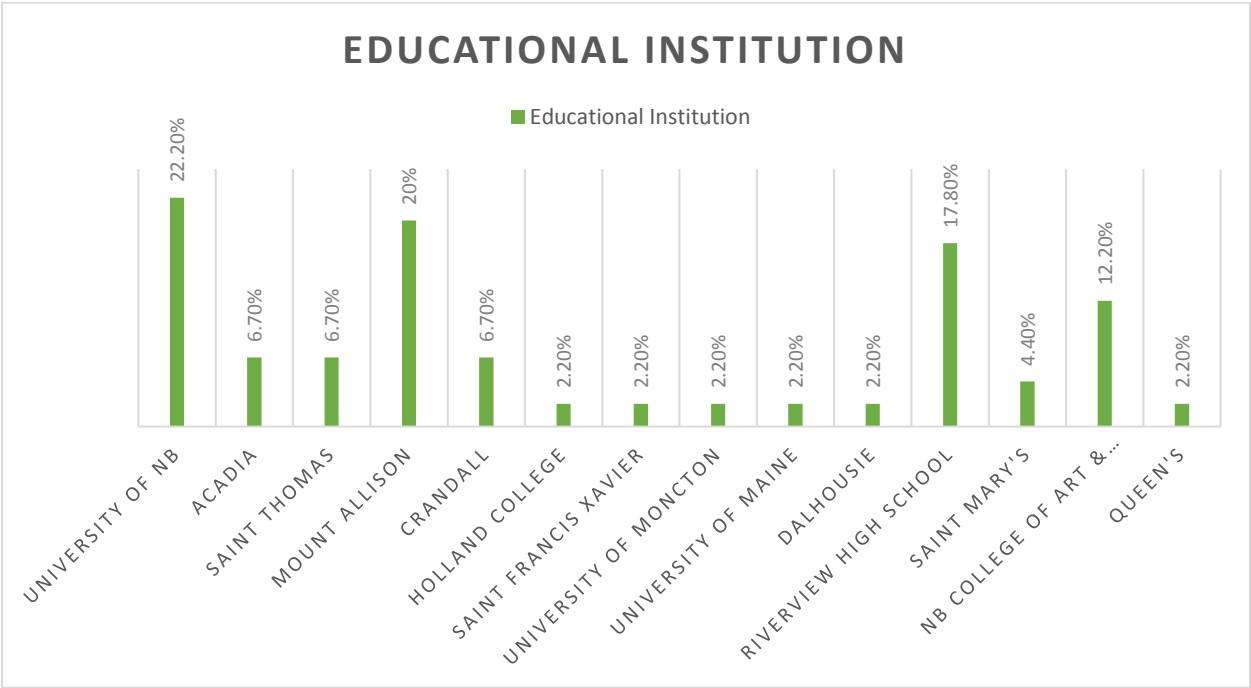

The 45 positions, as listed below, had been filled at the beginning of the summer season.

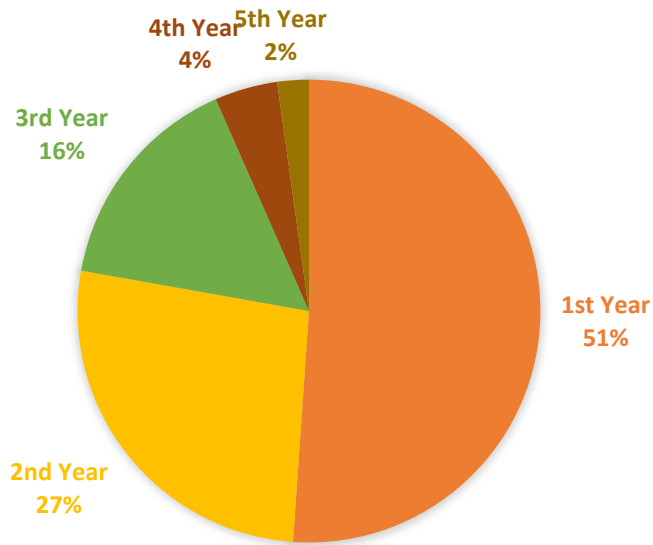
