Operations	 Chief hosted an EMO Information group meeting with participants from Riverview, Fredericton and Perth – Andover. Veterans Dinner being organized by the Chief. Lions Club unable to help this year. The Knights of Columbus have agreed to assist. Chief attended a Provincial Trunk Mobile Radio meeting. The new Regional dispatching system should be in service in the next 6 months. No additional cost to Riverview. Training continues with the new breathing apparatuses. We hope to have them in service by the end of Oct.

- Ladder truck annual testing has been completed, there were a few issues with the truck. It has now been repaired and it is now fully serviceable.
- Air compressor updated to permit filling of new breathing air cylinders.
