Asphalt Concrete Paving Various Streets (22-50)	 Contractor: MacArthur's paving and Construction Co. Ltd Scope of work of this project Asphalt seal (Montgomery Phase 1, Toth) Asphalt resurfacing (Canusa, Pitt) Construction notices delivered in May to residents on Montgomery, Toth, Canusa and Pitt.

	Construction started May 30 th and was completed within schedule at the end of June.
Street Paving and Curb & Sidewalk Work (22-54)	 Contractor: MacDonald Paving and Construction, a division of Miller Paving Limited. Scope of work of this project Asphalt resurfacing (Irving Ph3, Trites) New curb & sidewalk, Irving Ph3 (Lawson to Charyl) and new sidewalk Pinewood (Flagstone to Greenpark) Gunningsville trail, pavement reconstruction (Pine Glen to Country Club) Construction notices delivered in May to residents on Irving and Trites. Construction started May 30th and was completed within schedule on September 2, 2022.
Traffic Lane Markings - Various Street	 Contractor: Stripe Works Ltd. Pre-construction meeting was done June 23rd The lane markings were completed at the end of July, but contractor will be coming back to do new paved section of Trites Road in September.
Wilson Road Watermain Renewal	 Contractor: Bowsers' Construction Ltd Construction started 2 weeks behind schedule due to an issue with temporary water (needed to add an apartment to the temporary water system at Coverdale Road), the revised contract date is August 16th to October 17th. Communication: The following notices have been delivered: ✓ Temporary piping notices delivered in May. ✓ Notice of construction delivered early-August Pre-construction meeting was done July 14th. Construction is ongoing
Ridgeway Drive Reconstruction	 Contractor: Bowsers' Construction Ltd The revised construction period is June 13 to September 22. Project is running behind schedule by approximately 3 weeks. Communication: The following notices have been delivered: ✓ Temporary piping notices delivered in April. ✓ Notice of construction delivered June 3rd.

Pine Glen / Pinewood Roundabout	 Contractor: Modern Construction (1983) Limited. Project reached substantial performance July 5, 2022. Project completed within schedule and on budget.
Montgomery Ave Phase 2 (Coverdale to Fairfax) & Fairfax & Bradford East (Cleveland to Montgomery)	 Contractor: Foulem Construction Ltée Anticipated construction period is May 16 to end of October. Project within schedule and on budget. Communication: The following notices have been delivered: ✓ Temp water service notices delivered in May. ✓ Notice of construction delivered in May ✓ Curb and Sidewalk notices have been delivered to affected residents.
U/G Wires (relace) – Brewster and Pembroke	 Contractor: Roadway Systems Ltd. The construction work is scheduled for early October. Due to the amount of trees on Brewster and to minimize the damages to branches and roots most of the work will be done by directional drilling. The underground electrical work on Pembroke will be differed to 2023 due to increase in cost of the directional drilling decision on Brewster.
