The process will continue in October. • Hurricane Fiona resulted in several storm related emergency calls. Crews and apparatus were ready and responded as required. Pre-planning was conducted and proves again to be a valuable tool to achieve successful outcomes.

Chief True and Lt. Maxwell also instructed one session at this year's workshop.
