Traffic Lane Markings - Various Street	 Contractor: Stripe Works Ltd. The contractor should be back in Town to complete the newly paved section of Trites Road and other minor (but important) markings before the end of October. 	
Wilson Road Watermain Renewal	 Contractor: Bowsers' Construction Ltd Construction started 2 weeks behind schedule due to an issue with temporary water (needed to add an apartment to the temporary water system at Coverdale Road), the revised contract date is August 16th to October 28th. Communication: The following notices have been delivered: ✓ Temporary piping notices delivered in May. ✓ Notice of construction delivered early-August 	



	Construction is ongoing and due to extra days, as per the terms of the contract, the revised completion is now October 28 th .
Ridgeway Drive Reconstruction	 Contractor: Bowsers' Construction Ltd Ridgeway was originally scheduled for 13 weeks from May 30 to August 26. The anticipated rate of construction is based on 10 years of historical projects of similar nature. The project started 2 weeks behind schedule (i.e. June 13) at the request of the Contractor. They could not have materials on-site before then. The end date was adjusted by 2 weeks to September 9. The street has been ready and waiting for the concrete sub-contractor since October 6. The curb machine arrived on October 18. We believe the curb work will start October 20. The new watermain passed all tests. The sewers passed all CCTV review. Work left to do: Concrete curbs, landscaping lawns, restoring driveways (paving, concrete), 2nd layer of granular on street, fine grading, paving. Based on current rate of productivity, we believe the work could be done in approximately 4 weeks, i.e. November 18 +/
Montgomery Ave Phase 2 (Coverdale to Fairfax) & Fairfax & Bradford East (Cleveland to Montgomery)	 Contractor: Foulem Construction Ltée Project is on schedule and on budget. Communication: The following notices have been delivered: ✓ Temp water service notices delivered in May. ✓ Notice of construction delivered in May ✓ Curb and Sidewalk notices have been delivered to affected residents.
2023 Capital Projects	Design of proposed upcoming 2023 capital projects is ongoing and cost estimates have been provided to director.
U/G Wires (relace) – Brewster and Pembroke	 Contractor: Roadway Systems Ltd. The construction work on Brewster is now scheduled for the last week of October. Notice of construction delivered October 14th.
