Priority	Status
Administration	 TMR radio project implementation scheduled for December 21, 2022. We continue to participate in implementation meetings with Bell and DTI Radio Communications. Tri-community ERP revisions completed with Moncton and Dieppe. Highlights to be presented to council in January of 2023.
Operations	 Pre-Build meetings with rescue-pumper manufacturer were held. Physical testing for volunteer firefighter recruits was conducted. There will be thirteen candidates moving to the interview phase in November.



	 Permanent Officer meeting with F/T Officers & Chief Officers was held. Ongoing operational objectives were reviewed and/or updated.
Training	 In October a total of 346 training hours were accumulated, including: PPE Inspection, hose line advancement & search, power tool safety & familiarization. Eight career firefighters were recertified in Basic Life Support (CPR) One Chief Officer certified in Blue Card Incident Command.
Fire Prevention & Education Report	 Fire Inspections There was a total of four (4) fire safety inspection conducted in October, all four were apartment buildings. Fire Prevention & Education Crews attended a day care and performed a fire truck tour and fire safety talk. There were three fire station tours of school children. Held the Fire Prevention week Open House at the fire station on October 15th, hosting approximately 800 visitors. RFR now has 2,975 followers on Facebook. Five posts related to fire safety during fire prevention week reached a combined 2,923 people. Fire Investigation There were no fires in October, requiring investigation.
