Subject: Revised Municipal Emergency Response Plan



BACKGROUND

In 2018 the Town of Riverview, the City of Moncton and the City of Dieppe approved a shared municipal emergency response plan (MERP). Prior to this time, the Town of Riverview maintained it own MERP. Under the *New Brunswick Emergency Measures Act*, municipalities are required to establish a MERP and periodically review the MERP to ensure it is up to date.

PROCESS

In the spring and fall of 2022, the Directors of Emergency Measures from the three municipalities met, to review and revise the tri-community MERP.

The revised document requires the approval of all three municipal Councils.

RESULTS

In large part, sections 1-4 of the MERP required minimal changes. Most amendments could be best described as "housekeeping" amendments.

The appendices in section 5 have been improved to include standardized forms for the declaration and termination of a State of Local Emergency, as well as a standard form for evacuation advisories.

STRATEGIC PLAN

Revision of the Municipal Emergency Measures Plan is in alignment with our strategic plan. Strategic Theme: Safe & Inclusive Community. Objective: Residents feel their families and property are safe.

RECOMMENDATIONS FROM STAFF

I recommend that the Riverview Town Council approve adoption of the revised Municipal Emergency Response Plan.
