<b>Operations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Capital Project 23-22, MSA Confined Space Air Cart, was purchased and delivered. The equipment will be placed in service once training is completed.</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Capital Project 23-25, Auora 850lx Responder (Argo) was awarded. When the Argo is delivered it will replace the existing UTV.</li> <li>• The annual inspection of all ground ladders has been completed.</li> </ul>
<b>Training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At total of 223.75 training hours were obtained in February. Topics of instruction included: Calling a MAYDAY; Hoisting fire equipment; Taking manual blood pressures; Building construction; Pre-planning tour of the Operations Centre.</li> <li>• Several firefighters completed an on-line module on fire and explosion hazards associated with lithium-ion batteries from the UL Fire Safety Academy.</li> <li>• Seven volunteer firefighters completed the theory portion of a Ice Rescue Technician course.</li> <li>• A volunteer firefighter Level 1 course has commenced with seven students. Instruction provided by instructors from RFR.</li> <li>• Deputy Malloy attended a Fire Cause &amp; Origin 2 course and has now commenced Fire Cause &amp; Origin 3 online training.</li> </ul>
