Subject: Mill Creek Nature Park Masterplan 2023



BACKGROUND

Mill Creek Nature Park is a flourishing 330-acre (134 hectares) nature park located in the Town of Riverview. Riverview residents have embraced Mill Creek Nature Park as a year-round destination to be active, socialize, relax, and connect with nature. The park serves the 20,654 residents of Riverview, with residents from the surrounding communities of Moncton and Dieppe also visiting the park on a daily, weekly and monthly basis.

A 2013 Mill Creek Nature Park Master Plan laid the foundational groundwork for today's nature park, defining the role of the park, strategies that ensure protection from adjacent development, and a series of projects that expanded the role of passive park enjoyment.

The Town of Riverview awarded a Request for Proposal (RFP) on March 28, 2022 to engage the services of a firm to create a redeveloped masterplan. The updated plan is intended to act as a guide for future park development, associated programming and services to ensure the Town continues to provide residents with high quality services, support the community's growth and foster an appreciation of the natural environment.



After significant community consultation, the following vision statement was developed to guide future park developments and projects in the future. It is intended to support both the park's active use, while respecting the need for protection of the natural environment.

With interconnected forest spaces and aquatic environments, Mill Creek Nature Park maintains and protects the functional integrity of its ecosystems and the prominent natural features that define its landscape character. It is the "green heart" of Riverview, providing habitat for wildlife, active and passive recreational opportunities and access to nature for residents and visitors, and a place where the natural and cultural heritage is recognized and celebrated.

Figure 8 of the plan recommends various projects to stabilize, position and evolve the Mill Creek Nature Park and is intended to serve as a roadmap for the next fifteen years, or as resources permit.
