Sweeping	 Town has had first pass on all streets with sweeper. Starting on second pass
Lawn Repair	Lawn repairs are ongoing. Crews have made significant head way already this season
Temp Water	 Temporary water installation has been installed for the following capital projects: Windsor Elmore Hillsborough Inwood The rest of the temp water installation will be done in a second phase later this summer
Line Painting	 The line painting truck is ready, and crews have had some training. We are waiting on materials to arrive prior to starting. The work will start with the new linear line painting truck. As time permits, a second crew will commence crosswalks and arrows then proceed with work on symbols, stop bars and bike lanes which will continue throughout the summer.
Sewer Cleaning / CCTV	• Sewer cleaning has taken place for a significant section for our 2023 season. Crews have already cleaned and videoed streets north of Sussex bordered by Trites and Buckingham.
