Construction started on July 24th The anticipated completion date is October 25. Buckingham intersection Design, equipment selection is managed by Engineering traffic signal controller Dept. Equipment was ordered early June and has recently been received. Construction started at the end September; the work will be completed in November. The project was awarded to Roadways System Ltd. Replacing u/g Wires -The conduit was installed, and the new power disconnect Pembroke, Henderson box has been installed. The work is being coordinated with NB Power, subject to their schedule, the work should be done before the end of October. The project was awarded to MacDonald Applicators Ltd. Runneymeade Tank on May 8<sup>th</sup>. Upgrades and Relining The antenna mounting rail review is underway.

Description	Status
Sweeping	Street sweeping is on going as needed. Crews focusing on sections with leaves to ensure catch basins are open

Temp Water	Temp water is complete for 2023. All residents are off the temp water and on the new mains installed during capital projects.
Line Painting	All line painting is complete for 2023 with the exception of some stop bars in east Riverview. These are ongoing as weather and temperature permit. PW suspects to finish these within the next week
Sewer Cleaning / CCTV	Fall sewer cleaning is taking place in the Callowhill area
Concrete Work	Concrete crew is in the process of doing curb and sidewalk repairs. To date this summer, crews have placed over 18m³ of concrete in different repairs around town.
Winter Prep	Crews continue to prepare for winter (pumping hydrants, inspecting plow equipment, stockpiling salt and gravels)

### **Gunningsville Bridge**

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure has attempted to make repairs to the driving surface of the bridge. No activity yet on the plan to repair the damaged railing.

We are still waiting on the smart sensor controller to arrive for the intersection. Unfortunately, motorists may experience some delays at the intersection until the new controller is installed.

# Codiac Transpo

Attached is the latest dashboard, prepared by our IT department, of the ridership for Riverview for September 2023. The ridership continues to grow, and Riverview's September counts are now the highest 1 month count ever.

The Codiac drivers approached us this summer with some proposed minor improvements. The changes will provide better routing consistency, help alleviate tight timing for connectors with Moncton routes, and address safety concerns. These will be communicated to users and the changes will take place in November.
