Snow Removal	<ul> <li>It has been a quiet beginning of the year. We have had 3 significant events of precipitation. Crews has been monitoring the weather and applying salt when temperatures fall below freezing.</li> </ul>
	We have used the alert to restrict parking 9 days out of 31 in December and 6 days out of 16 in January.
Asphalt Patching	Crews have been using the asphalt recycler and have made placed 18.5 tonnes so far this January. This would equate to roughly \$6,900.00 in patching costs.
Maintenance	Crews have taken the opportunity leading up to the most recent snow events to ensure gear is ready for our operations. PW employees have worked together to ensure repairs and modifications have taken place for not only winter equipment but summer equipment as well. This will help reduce workload leading into spring season.

### Section 4: Other Notable Development & Highlights for Council's Attention:

#### Watermain Replacement Program - Yearly update

The following two charts depict the amount of watermain breaks on cast iron pipes within the Town and the level of efforts to replace these pipes over the years. In 2023, we had 16 breaks and replaced over 2,100m of CI with new PVC. Since 2006, Council has made a considerable investment towards efforts of replacing cast iron water pipes. These efforts have shown a significant reduction in the amounts of water breaks from an average of 44 breaks per year prior in 2006 to 16 breaks last year. So far, we have replaced almost 30km of mainline water pipes. We still have approximately 36km (or 31% of the overall system) of cast iron water mains to replace.
