<b>Administration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Logistical preparation is underway for two new career members who begin work in March 2024.</li> <li>• The final public document for the 2024-28 RFR Strategic Plan is being finalized for presentation in late February.</li> </ul>
<b>Operations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updates were made to the department’s Standard Operating Guidelines related to ARGO Operations and Emergency Vehicle Operations. A new guideline was developed for Lithium-Ion Battery Fires/Incidents.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The truck committee has commenced work on specifications for the replacement of the current 75' aerial apparatus.</li> </ul>
<b>Training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A total of 221.5 total training hours were completed in January. Topics included: Ice rescue review; ARGO winter operations; lifting bags (auto extrication); Dust collector fires; search and entanglement drills.</li> <li>• The EMO coordinator and deputy coordinator both obtained their ICS Planning Section Chief certifications.</li> <li>• The 2024 volunteer firefighter recruitment class commenced Firefighter Level 1 training with six students. Four additional new members with prior training commenced in-house orientation training.</li> </ul>
