Subject: Wildland-Urban Interface Fire Risk

<u>BACKGROUND</u> A Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) fire is one where various structures, usually private homes and other developments meet, or are intermingled with, wildland fuel fires. There is significant risk to public and private property associated with WUI fires, which may also include community evacuations. FireSmart Canada is an organization that is solely focused on assisting communities with mitigating the risk posed by WUI fires. Riverview Fire and Rescue is partnering with DNRE as well as FireSmart Canada to hold an information session on Saturday, May 4, 2024, from 10:00am until 12:00pm at the Riverview Fire Hall. It is our hope that the residents of Riverview begin to learn how they can mitigate their risk by attending this information session.
