**Section 2: Status of Department's Operational Priorities for 2023**

Priority	Status
<b>Administration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Community Risk Assessment (fire and rescue specific) is 60% complete. When completed, this will be presented to Council.</li></ul>
<b>Operations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Three sea-can containers were received at the training grounds for expansion of the live fire facility (Capital Project #24-20 – Live Fire Training Area).</li><li>With completion of new firefighter training, Shift #2 and #3 now have a minimum staffing of five firefighters. Shift #1 and #4 have a minimum staffing of four firefighters.</li></ul>

<b>Training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A total of 609.25hrs of training were recorded in April, including: Blue Card incident command training; swiftwater rescue training; fire dynamics; medical First Responder; wildland firefighting operations.</li> <li>• Training of two new career firefighters concluded during April.</li> <li>• Five students have completed 25% of the Level 1 firefighter course.</li> <li>• Five career firefighters recertified in Swiftwater Rescue Operations Level II.</li> <li>• Six career firefighters received their initial Blue Card Incident Command certification.</li> <li>• Eight volunteer firefighters completed the Emergency Firefighter course (NB-DNRE Wildland Firefighter).</li> </ul>
<b>Fire Prevention &amp; Education Report</b>	<p><u>Fire Inspections</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There was a total of one (1) fire safety inspection conducted in April. An occupancy load was also completed for this business.</li> </ul> <p><u>Fire Prevention &amp; Education</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There were a total of three fire station tours conducted in the month of April.</li> <li>• There were three presentations completed in the month of April (Wildland Urban Interface, Inspection Cycle Process, Fire Safety Presentation Lakeview Towers).</li> <li>• Two media interviews were conducted regarding the Wildland Urban Interface Fire Smart Prep Day.</li> <li>• Prepared for an Educational Presentation of an encapsulating agent (similar to foam) and had multiple fire services involved for a lecture and live presentation of F-500 Encapsulating Agent by Hazard Control Technologies Representative.</li> </ul> <p><u>Fire Investigation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There were no fires in April requiring investigation.</li> </ul>
