Thank you for your letter dated May 16, 2024, regarding streetlights along Findlay Boulevard in Riverview.

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DTI) does not provide for linear lighting along the length of a highway. The department provides for lighting at intersections which meet Transportation Association of Canada (TAC) guidelines, structures, or ramps.

If the town wishes to install and maintain luminaires along Findlay Boulevard, the Department will have no objection provided the installation meets current standards. This has been done in other communities throughout the province. Costs associated with the installation and future maintenance would be the responsibility of the community through the local tax base.
