Crews plan to continue to patch these with hot mix asphalt from the recycler. In the event we need to respond quickly to a few potholes around town with a temporary fix, we have restocked our cold patch material as well.
Snow	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Crews continue to battle snow events as they appear.
