


Section 4: Other Notable Development & Highlights for Council's Attention:

The following two charts depict the amount of watermain breaks on cast iron pipes within the Town and the level of efforts to replace these pipes over the recent years. In 2017, we had 24 breaks and replaced over 3km of CI with new PVC. Our efforts have shown to make a significant reduction in the amounts of breaks. Since the start of the Cast Iron watermain replacement program, we have replaced 15.2 km in 11 years. We still have 34km of problematic cast iron water mains to replace.




