Subject: CRPA agreement with Province for 911 services

Background and Agreement Overview

Codiac RCMP has been engaged in negotiations for a new 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Agreement with the Government of New Brunswick since 2024. These negotiations have involved collaboration with all six PSAPs across the Province, resulting in a successful agreement with the Province.

Approval Process and Municipal Involvement

During the approval process, a challenge arose for the Codiac and Saint John regions. The Government of New Brunswick now requires that the contract be signed directly by the municipalities served by the regional entity, rather than by the Boards responsible for overseeing police services.

Council Action Required

As a result, this matter is presented to Council to request a motion authorizing the Mayor and Town Clerk to sign the agreement on behalf of the Town of Riverview. Moncton and Dieppe are also seeking similar direction from their respective Councils.

Agreement Implementation and Financial Impact

The agreement, which will take effect on 2025-04-01, outlines the terms for the continued provision of 9-1-1 services. The updated agreement includes an increase in compensation to the Codiac 911 centre, with the total amount owing set at \$203,248.73.
