Section 4: Other Notable Development & Highlights for Council's Attention:

On February 16, the Director, Mr. Ouellet, along with the Municipal Engineers attended the Association of Professional Engineers Association (APEGNB) Annual Conference and Meeting. The causeway bridge project was presented by the DTI. Since I was in the audience, I took the opportunity to answer questions on traffic concerns related to the anticipated full closure of the causeway from June to December 2020 expressed by resident engineers of Riverview in attendance. This allowed an opportunity to quickly present the upcoming Gunningsville Intersection Reconfiguration project to this audience.

Nathan Orr, Superintendent of Public works, attended the **DEKRA Professional Development Conference**. The conference provided workshops and sessions offered across a range of safetyrelated topics with an emphasis on practical application, employee engagement, and continuous improvement.

GIS / Asset Management Service – New service provided by the Southeast Regional Service Commission (SERSC) to its partner municipalities. The purpose of this Asset Inventory and Management service is to provide municipalities with an online system to visualize and provide information about their infrastructure assets and to update the data over time. The approach outlined below provides at no cost to Riverview with the possibility of additional services as the need arises. The service would start by providing their up-to date inventory data in a digital format (CAD or GIS) and the SERSC would host this data and provide a web-map through a secure website. This web-map can be used to identify the location assets in the field or office, as well as view information about each asset (material, size, age, etc.). **Management of Natural Assets** - In Riverview, like many other municipalities across Canada, infrastructure is starting to show its age and service delivery expectation continues to increase. Due to development, ecosystems are in decline in many municipalities and climate change is exacerbating these challenges. The SERSC was successful in acquiring funding for an 18 month pilot project, funded by the Smart Prosperity Institute (SPI), and at no cost to the Town. Our commitment is our time to support the SERSC in using Riverview as the pilot municipality.

Working with the SERSC, the Town will be able to inventory the municipality's existing natural assets. Natural assets are ecosystem features that provide, or could be restored to provide, services just like the other engineered assets, but historically have not been considered on equal footing or included in asset management plans. At a minimum, this approach will help Riverview manage risk by better understanding what services come from natural assets using the same systems as for engineered assets to secure sustainable service delivery.
