Canadian Blood Scandal

- More than 30,000 Canadians are infected with hepatitis C and 2,000 people with HIV.
- Estimated 8,000 Canadians will die.
- Justice Krever Inquiry Canadian Blood Services replaced Canadian Red Cross.

Canadian Blood Services

- Plasma, just like whole blood, is a public resource that must be safeguarded for Canadians.
- Long-term security of the plasma supply for immune globulin (Ig) can only be achieved through increased plasma collection by the publicly funded and publicly accountable not-for-profit blood system operated by Canadian Blood Services. (News release, January 24, 2017).

Canadian Plasma Resources

- For-profit company.
- Parent company ExaPharma, owned and operated by the Riahi family (Iran).
- Business partnership with Botest AG, a German pharmaceutical company (13 plasma collections centres in Europe and 22 in the US) Revenue 2015: \$825,6 million.

Canadian Plasma Resources

2012 - Oppened two clinics in Ontario close to a
Toronto men's shelter and a Hamilton methadone clinic
2014 - Government of Ontatio passed a *Voluntary Blood Donations Act*. Both clinics were closed
2016- CPR opened a for-profit centre in Saskatoon.
2017 Alberta passed a Voluntary Blood Donation legislation.

Quebec has banned the sale of human blood or plasma.

Canadian Plasma Resources

- 2017 CPR opens a clinic in Moncton
- Target clients:
- ✓ Students (Université de Moncton, Crandall University, Mount Alison University, Community Colleges, Oulton College, High Schools).
- **✓** People living in poverty.
- ✓ General public.
- Pay: \$25 Visa gift card. Frequent donors: Bonuses: Super Hero Rewards, monthly draws, etc.

Conclusion

If we accept a for-profit company like Canadian Plasma Resources, it will:

- Affect the volunteer aspect of our blood and plasma collection system.
- Not help our national supply of plasma.
- Exploit Canadians for profits.

Solutions

- Keep our blood and plasma donation system voluntary.
- □Increase the amount of plasma collected.
- □Increase public awareness of our needs.
- ■Province pass a Voluntary Blood Donations Act.
