


In Canada, head trauma is the #1 leading cause of severe injuries and deaths in children who have been in a bicycle accident?


For whom? Youth ages 5-18 years old. Where?

Riverview, Moncton and Dieppe communities.


When?

Process of Positive Ticketing

- Distribution of a Positive Ticket by RCMP/community agencies;
 Fill out Positive Ticket by recipient or by
 - parent/guardian;



- Deposit Positive Ticket in designated ballot box situated in one of the three Provincial libraries.
- * Public Health will be responsible for ballot boxes and prizes during the summer*
