Byron Dobson Arena Phase 1 - Facilities Upgrade and Improvement, Re: Package R1 (TOR 17-41A) - Refrigeration Plant Motor Control Center Upgrade **Tender Evaluation and Letter of Recommendation** MCW Project No. 11-17-120

#### Introduction

The tenders have closed for the work for Refrigeration Plant Motor Control Center Upgrade (Package R1) at Byron Dobson Arena, Riverview, New Brunswick.

The following is a summary of the tenders and our recommendation.

#### Scope of the Work 1.

The work in the tender documents generally includes:

- 1. Specialized refrigeration, electrical, and controls services related to the design, implementation, and commissioning of a turn-key Motor Control Center and controls system upgrade for the existing Upper Rink and Lower Rink ammonia refrigeration plants at the Byron Dobson Arena.
- 2. Each of the two (2) plants will include the supply and install of new standalone motor control center panels and new control systems. Each plant will include separate systems and will include:
  - Remove the existing Motor Control Centers within the plant. Decommission the existing systems.
  - Supply and install new soft starter systems for the compressor No.1 and No.2. The Upper Rink ice plant soft starters on the compressors can be re-used.







- Supply and install new Motor Control Centers for each plant. The centers will replace all
  existing systems and provide as a minimum equipment services for alarms, and controls.
  Panels to be designed and fabricated by a CSA panel shop for field mounting.
- The new Motor Control Centers must provide the necessary safety, reliability, and operator specific features which are required to run the plant in a safe, efficient manner.
- Supply and install a new Variable Frequency Drive (stand-alone) for control over the Evaporative Condenser Fan on each cooling tower.
- Supply and install a new ice plant control system. The control system shall be supplied to be
  integrated into the new Motor Control Center and coordinated as part of the CSA assembly and
  certification at a panel shop. The controls provider to work with the CSA panel shop to
  integrated the new hardware into the panel assembly.
- 3. Provide Training on the new automation and controls.
- 4. Provide commissioning for all field instruments, loop testing, operational test, alarm simulation and documentation.
- 5. This Contractor will be considered the Prime Contractor for this work. They are responsible for all trades, materials and coordination aspects of the job. Errors or omissions by sub-trade will be the responsibility of this Contractor.

The budget for the work is:

#### 2. Tender Process

MCW Maricor prepared the technical drawings and specifications. MCW provided the contract requirements and general conditions ('front-end') specifications based on the Town of Riverview front end tender documents. The information was advertise and made available publically. There was a non-mandatory bidders meeting held at the site. One Addendum was issued.

The Tenders were received at the Town Hall of Town of Riverview on June 22, 2017 and opened in public immediately after the close.

The Bidders were as follows:

1. Black & McDonald Ltd.

The summary of Tender responses from the Bidders and the Lump Sum bids were submitted as follows:

1. Black & McDonald Ltd. \$188,450.00 + HST

#### 4. Tender Analysis

Price - There was only one bidder from Black & McDonald Ltd.

Schedule – The required construction completion date is September 8th, 2017. B&M matched the required schedule.
