Subject: Expropriation of Land-Corner of Pinewood Road and Pine Glen Road



#### **BACKGROUND**

In order to accommodate the future roundabout project at the intersection of Pinewood Road and Pine Glen Road, scheduled for 2021, the Town of Riverview needs to acquire a portion of land located at that intersection. As the town only needs a portion of the land and the property owner will only sell in its entirety, the Town will begin an expropriation process to acquire the piece.

As a first step in the expropriation process, Council must pass a resolution authorizing staff and their agents to enter the land in order to survey and obtain an appraisal.

This resolution, which is presented at the Committee of the Whole for Council's recommendation to the next Regular Council Meeting, will read as follows:

WHEREAS it is council's intention to investigate expropriating land located at the corner of Pine Glen Road and Pinewood Road and identified as PID #05058060; and

WHEREAS Section 5(1) of the Expropriations Act states that "any expropriating authority...may, without the consent of the owner, enter upon any land to ascertain its suitability for the purposes for which its expropriation is required", et al; and

WHEREAS Section 5(4) of the Expropriations Act states that "No agent or employee of an expropriating authority that is a local government shall enter on land under the authority of subsection (1) unless the entry has been previously authorized by a resolution of the council of the local government";

THEREFORE the Town Council of the Town of Riverview authorizes its employees and/or a designated agent of the town to enter the premises identified as PID #05058060 in order to perform a survey and appraisal of the land.

## **CONSIDERATIONS**

#### Legal:

Staff have met with legal counsel to discuss the necessary steps required to expropriate land. Staff will be following these steps and keeping council appraised of the situation as it progresses.

## Financial:

There will obviously be some costs associated with the expropriation process in terms of purchase of the land, appraisal fees, etc.

## Interdepartmental Consultation:

Communication has been and will continue to take place between departments regarding this project.

## **Communication Plan:**

All communication with the property owner will take place according to the Expropriations Act and Regulations.

## **RECOMMENDATION FROM STAFF**

Staff recommends that Council approve the passing of the resolution at the next Regular Meeting of Council on December 10, 2018.
